Event Details

- Opening Ceremony at 9am. Please join us for our special survivor walk and Presentation of Colors, followed by general briefing and course walk-throughs.

- Baton will be given to first team member, which will perform Rally course.



Rally...Course will be a combination of 10 novice and advanced signs. Dog can be on or off-leash, handler's choice.

- After completion of Rally, the baton will be handed off to next team member, who will perform Agility.



Agility...The course will include a combination of jumps, tunnels and a set of 6 weaves.

- After completion of Agility, the baton will be handed off to next team member, who will perform Dock Jumping.



Dock Jumping...The dog may/may not jump from the dock but must retrieve the item from the pond and bring it back to the handler.

- After completion of Dock Jumping, the baton will be handed off to next team member, who will perform Nature Trail.



Nature Trail...This event will require the handler to work the dog while keeping contact with bicycle at all times. Dog will be required to perform following tasks: log jump, bridge walk, water obstacle (ankle high) and hay bale climb. (Bicycle will be provided.)

- The final event is Herding.



Herding event will be at started level. Team will be required to perform a gather. Course will also include Y-chute and re-pen.

After the completion of Herding course, the handler & dog will race to deposit the baton to the bucket.

Each team has 8 minutes to complete entire relay.

Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability

1. Assumption of Risk: The undersigned is aware of the inherent Risks of injury, death and property damage to the undersigned, to his or her dog(s) that are involved in the recreational activity of canine agility, including without limitations, risks due to dog bite, the use of agility equipment, or infectious disease and is participating voluntarily. The undersigned is aware of the risks of injury, death and property damage that may result from, among other causes, the active or passive negligence of Performance Dogs In Action, INC.
2. Release of Liability: The undersigned releases Performance Dogs In Action, Inc. from all liability to the "undersigned" representatives, guardians, successors, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for all liability, claims, damage, or demands for personal injury, death, or property damage to the undersigned or the undersigned's dog or dogs, arising from or related to this agreement. This release includes, without limitation, any personal injury, death, or property damage caused by the active or passive negligence of Performance Dogs In Action, Inc. The undersigned bears responsibility for any loss.
3. Knowing and Voluntary Execution: The undersigned acknowledges that he or she has carefully read this agreement, understands its contents, and understands that this agreement includes an assumption of risk of Performance Dogs In Action, Inc. negligence and a release of their liability. The undersigned acknowledges that Performance Dogs In Action, Inc. are materially relying on this waiver in allowing the undersigned to participate in this dog agility event.
4. I also state that my dog(s) are not aggressive towards people or other dogs and that I understand that I alone am responsible for the behavior of my dog(s), that any dog, which is out of control, creates an unnecessary disturbance or engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may at the discretion of the organizing committee, be expelled from the event grounds with NO REFUNDS.

Driving Directions

From Sacramento: Take 5 North to 99 North. Exit East (right) on Riego Road. Follow to the 2nd stop sign at Pleasant Grove Road and make a left heading North. Performance Dogs in Action is 1.5 miles up on the left side of the road.

From Roseville: Take Baseline west about 12 miles from Foothills Road. At the Riego Market and stop sign, Baseline Road turns into Riego Road. At the next stop sign, turn North (right) onto Pleasant Grove Road. Performance Dogs in Action is 1.5 miles up on the left side of the road.

From the South / East Bay: Take Highway 580 East to Tracy. Merge onto Highway 205 toward Stockton and continue on Highway 5 North to Sacramento. Merge onto Highway 99 North (also Highway 70N) via exit #525B and head towards Yuba City/Marysville. Exit East (right) on Riego Road. Follow to the 2nd stop sign at Pleasant Grove Road and make a left heading North. Performance Dogs in Action is 1.5 miles up on the left side of the road.

From the North Bay: Take Highway 37 East to Vallejo/Napa. Merge onto Interstate 80 East. Merge onto Highway 5 North / Highway 99 North. Merge onto CA99/North (also Highway 70N) via exit #525B and head towards Yuba City/Marysville. Exit East (right) on Riego Road. Follow to the 2nd stop sign at Pleasant Grove Road and make a left heading North. Performance Dogs in Action is 1.5 miles up on the left side of the road.
